Micro Pub – Premises Licence Application

The consultation period for the premises license application for the micro pub at 4a Chester Green Rd ended on 8th October. 89 objections were submitted, on the grounds that; a music license would create a noise nuisance at night time to neighbours, particularly to families with children and the elderly; an Off License will encourage street drinking and noise disturbance during and after closing hours particularly on warm nights; that opening to 10.30pm(despite the Planning Control Committee conditioning closing at 10.00pm) will extend the noise nuisance to local residents and children sleeping; also that the sale of alco-pops and spirits is inappropriate in a pub of this type.

The Council's Environmental Health Officer also objected to a music license and the applicant withdrew his application for a music license on 8th October.

P.S. The public hearing held on November 1st was attended by an LCRA committee member, to try to ensure conditions were attached to the license, to reduce nuisance to local residents. The three Councillors on the Licensing committee granted an alcohol and off sales license, with conditions that sale of alcohol must finish at 10.00pm with customers leaving by 10.30pm;N.B.If residents have complaints about noise or smoking issues they should ring Environmental Protection 642020 or Food & Safety 641555

76% Rent Increase for City Road Council Garages

The LCRA have been sent a copy of correspondence from the Council's Estates Department , who manage the City Rd council garages. This confirmed their agreement with elected members from the previous administration, to phase in rent increases over 4 years to bring them in line with Derby Homes garage rents. The Head of Estates had forgotten that a council report had been written and that this agreement had been made last year.

As a result of our reminder, the Head of Estates latest proposal is (for existing tenants only) to increase rents by 36% in Nov 2012, a further 13% increase in April 2013 to £400 per year, followed by 13% increase in April 2014 and 13% increase in April 2015. They propose that new and existing residents who would in future like to rent a garage, will have to pay £468 per year (20% more than Derby Homes residents pay to rent Derby Homes garages). Our request to be told how many and which garages are currently being rented has not been fully answered, but it seems that only 9 of the 30 garages are currently being rented, with 2 tenants considering ceasing tenancy due to unaffordability. This would mean a vacancy level of over 70%. This conflicts with Estates saying there was a waiting list of 20 before 15 garages were repaired and the other 15 were being rented. In response to our questioning the legality of increasing rents by 76%, the Chief Legal Officer has replied that the City Council Chief Executive, Adam Wilkinson, has delegated authority to the Head of Estates (Steve Meynall) to decide rent increases on all council assets. There is no obligation to seek approval from or even notify elected members (i.e. Ward Councillors or the elected Leader of the Council) whatever the size of increase. As we believe the councils strategy will result in empty garages, lost revenue, more parking congestion and ultimately the demolition of these garages, the LCRA will continue to campaign for sensible pricing to increase utilisation and retention of this community asset.
