

## A note from Rebecca Hudson Darley Ward Neighbourhood Partnership Officer - Darley Ward Christmas Planning — Help Needed

On a 'normal' year we would be looking at providing a sit down meal for a number of residents who are isolated / vulnerable or don't have any family, this year that isn't going to happen so we are looking at ideas around the following:

**Christmas meal, cooked and delivered** – we would need a venue to cook and people willing to help out on a day who have relevant qualifications (cooks, chefs etc), we would also need volunteers willing to deliver the meals. The food needed for the meal would include – meat & veg option, veg and pudding – we would need donations for the food. This may be held between Boxing Day and New Years for the meal.

**Hampers** – donations from residents and local businesses – these could be delivered Christmas Eve / Day.

**Choir** – For those residents that are unable to get out during this period a choir to visit streets where people could open windows, listen from their door steps – obviously following the current social distance guidance and groups of no more than 6. Routes and dates can be agreed on but to visit all parts of Darley Ward.

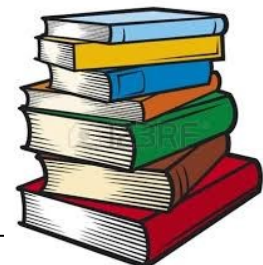
