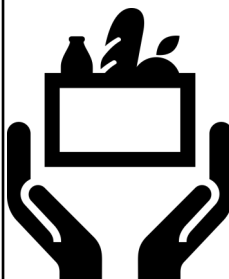

QUEEN'S LEISURE CENTRE CLOSURE CONSULTATION

There is a proposal to cease operation of the Queen's Leisure centre once the Moorways Aquapark opens (so, no swimming pool in the City Centre anymore!). The council has just opened a consultation to get Derby Residents' views as, in order to stay open, Queen's needs significant investment:

Why are they consulting?

With the opening of these new facilities along with other factors, including:

- the age and design of Queen's Leisure Centre is not suitable for modern leisure use
- the significant cost of repairs and maintenance required to maintain the facilities and bring all three pool halls back into use as well as the cost of large-scale refurbishment to keep the facility open in the long-term.
- that for the foreseeable future the teaching pool, changing rooms and the gym remain closed due to ongoing maintenance issues
- the current ongoing budgeted annual operating subsidy of £551,825.

The Council is proposing to cease operating the leisure provision at Queen's Leisure Centre when Moorways Sports Village opens in spring 2022.

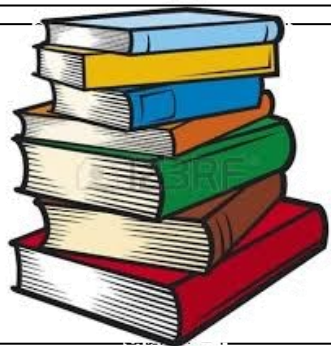

If anyone has any jigsaws for grown ups to donate, that'd be great!

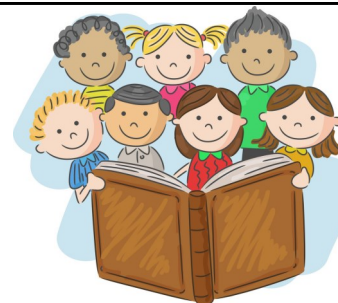
JUMP AHEAD READING CLUB
