PARKING PERMITS IN CHESTER GREEN

You may have seen notices up and around Chester Green stating that the cost for residents' parking permits is changing. For areas that currently pay for permits, this is, indeed, the case, and the council has a legal obligation to advertise the changes at all locations covered by parking permit schemes.

However, the permits in Chester Green **will remain free** until a decision has been made on whether the scheme will remain in place or not following a consultation exercise. It is hoped that this consultation will be carried out during the 2023-24 financial year.


